COMMUNITY WORKER AT THE SWISS CHURCH IN LONDON

We are looking for a person with experience in outreach and community work to run and supervise

Breakfast on the Steps

which is happening every Tuesday morning from 8am until 10am at the Swiss Church in Covent Garden. Breakfast on the Steps is part of the Swiss Church's outreach work for homeless people, but everybody is welcome. Usually we have about 30-40 guests.

Responsibilities:

- Food shopping and preparations, set up and tidying up with the support of volunteers and church cleaning company
- Coordinating volunteer rota and supervising volunteers
- Recruiting and training new volunteers, if needed, and obtaining their agreement to the terms of volunteering
- Occasionally supporting individual guests affected by homelessness in collaboration with partner institutions. The scope of individual support will be decided on a case to case basis together with the Minister.
- Coordinating haircuts for homeless people with hairdresser (every 4-6 weeks during breakfast)
- Coordinating monthly cooked breakfast with volunteers
- Basic administration; administer petty cash expenses in collaboration with Finance Officer
- Attending monthly team meetings and bi-annual church away day
- Writing a short article (400-500 words) for the quarterly church newspaper
- Building links with partner institutions, other charities and organisations

We are looking for a community worker who is:

- Experienced in working with homeless people or other vulnerable groups with a nonjudgmental and positive attitude
- Experienced in handling and de-escalating conflict situations, including dealing with those presenting with substance abuse, attempted drug-dealing and drug-taking and/or mental health challenges, and conflict between guests
- Experienced in working with volunteers and their sometimes unpredictable schedules and last minute changes

- A valued team of four (Minister, Lettings and Office Administrator, Community Worker and Finance Officer)
- Welcoming of people from all paths of life and from all church traditions or none regardless of age, race, gender or sexual identity.
- Offering training and development opportunities

Working hours: 8 hours per week (every Tuesday morning 6.45-11:15am, plus one morning or afternoon and some evening, as needed). Rarely working hours may fall on a weekend day (bi-annual church away day)

Salary: £15/hour, or up to £6'240 gross per annum
