## The Swiss Church in London Artist Residency 2024

## **About the Swiss Church in London Art Programme**

The Swiss Church in London is an open, creative and accessible space in a beautiful Grade II listed building in the heart of Covent Garden. In 2011, The 150-year-old church underwent a major renovation by architects Christ & Gantenbein. The project aimed to simultaneously create a space of worship and art, inspired by the white cube gallery concept.

Since this transformation, the Art Programme has been an integral part of the church alongside its community outreach and church services. It hosts a diverse roster of art exhibitions, events and academic collaborations throughout the year.

Since 2015, the Swiss Church in London has run an annual 3-month residency programme that supports artists, curators and creatives of diverse disciplines, providing them with the rare opportunity to have a central London studio and to showcase their work through a public exhibition.

## What do we offer?

The three-month residency includes 24-hour access to a studio space at the church, a £1500 stipend and a supported 4-day exhibition or a public event in the church hall at the end of the residency. It is an opportunity to work and produce a project within a sacred listed building with its own unique history.

Through this residency, we offer a platform for artists to experiment and create new work, connect with new communities and receive mentorship as well as professional development opportunities.

Who are we looking for?

Artists, art collectives, arts organisations or curators from all artistic disciplines based in the UK are

welcome to apply. The residency provides a safe environment for artists of all ethnic backgrounds, faiths, genders and sexualities. We particularly encourage artists from underrepresented groups

to apply.

Applicants must currently have the right to live and work in the UK. The applicants must

demonstrate a high standard of artistic quality or specialist skill alongside a track record of

exhibitions or public events.

We are looking for site-specific projects that could relate to one or more of the following: the value in community, migration and heritage, social and political issues or ideas surrounding faith and

spirituality.

What do we expect from you?

Successful applicants will be required to work at the Swiss Church in London for a minimum of two days per week. The artist is required to have their own public liability insurance - we can provide

advice on this.

The Artist in Residence needs to work collaboratively with the Art Programme Managers and team

by providing feedback and communicating regularly. They will also agree to monthly studio visits, a mentoring session from a member of the Art Programme's network, as well as a formal talk to

the team or Art Programme's network.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 23rd of April 2024, midnight.

Applications can also be made via video or voice recording. The Swiss Church is fully wheelchair
