In her documentary **Brunngasse 8**, Hildegard E. Keller embarks on a journey through time with six people and a mouse. The film explores Brunngasse 8, a house adorned with wall paintings dating back to around 1330. The survival of the hunting and dancing scenes in the courtly (Christian) style of the time is a small sensation. Their discovery sparked a great deal of interest, both nationally and internationally. The house's patrons came from a distinguished Jewish family who belonged to Zurich's elite. The film reflects on the value of history for those of us living today.

Hildegard E. Keller is a Swiss-born filmmaker, scholar and author. She has made significant contributions through her documentaries, novels, and performances. She uniquely revives historical figures like Alfonsina Storni and Hannah Arendt. She is a live storyteller in the streets of Zurich, drawing on her extensive experience as a professor of literature and a literary critic on Swiss television. She is an Artist in Residence in London, supported by the Landis & Gyr Foundation, and recently received the International Creative Media Award for her biography of Storni.
